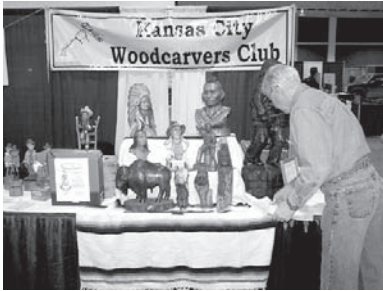

Carrot Soufflé

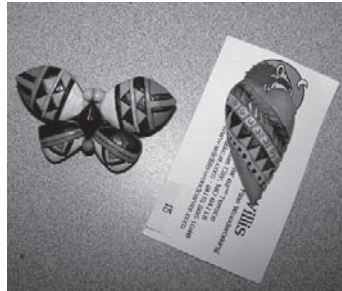
2 lbs.	Carrots	2t	Baking Powder
2/3 C	Butter, melted	2C	Brown Sugar
4 lg.	Eggs, Beaten	2t	Vanilla
6 T.	Flour		

Cook carrots in boiling water until tender. (We use the small carrots, about 2 inches, that come in a bag.) Drain the carrots. Put carrots, butter, eggs, flour, baking powder, sugar and vanilla in a food processor and run until smooth. (If you do not have a food processor, you could use a blender or a mixer.) Pour into a lightly greased baking dish. Bake at 350 for 1 hour or until set. Can be divided. We cover the dish while baking for about 45min. so the top will not get too dark.
